From the Desk of Father Rick Schilli



In last week's Gospel St. Peter steps boldly forward and professes his faith in Jesus, "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God." It is a crucial moment for Peter personally, but also for the Church as Jesus bestows the Petrine Ministry upon him. Today's Gospel reading continues the moment, but with a radically different tone. With one statement Jesus seems to pull the rock foundation out from beneath Peter's feet. The nature of discipleship in Jesus Christ is to "take up your cross and follow me". To these words Peter recoils and chastises Jesus, who in turn chastises Peter. Discipleship is about the Paschal Mystery. It is about dying and rising with Jesus Christ because that is the only way to eternal life. Just like Peter, these are words that quite often we simple do not want to hear, and yet where would we be spiritually with them. The way of the Cross provides for us meaning for our lives and an understanding that only faith can provide. At Jesus' urging today we are prompted to begin to think like God thinks and to reject the insufficient "wisdom" of human beings.

Today we welcome back about 350 children who are continuing their religious education in our Parish School of Religion. Once again this year we have three sessions of PSR, each having students K-8, many of them will be preparing for sacraments in our Church. It is the responsibility of the entire parish to educate the children in the faith by assisting their parents as the "first teachers of their children in the faith". In November nearly 70 children in the second grade of both Sacred Heart School and the PSR will be presented by their parents for the Sacrament of Penance for the first time. In April about 65 young men and women of our 8th grades will present themselves with their sponsors for the Sacrament of Confirmation to be conferred on them by Archbishop Carlson. In May those same 70 second graders will be presented to me to receive the Body and Blood of the Lord for the very first time. While the sacraments are most certainly highlights of religious education, they are not the totality of the learning and formation we hope will take place. Today I commend all these children to the Lord and to you for your prayerful support and good example of what it means to live our lives faithfully in Jesus Christ.

We are endeavoring to keep the contents of our Sunday bulletin as informative and current as possible. So, we are trying to include items of interest from the various ministries the parish has to offer. As you read through the bulletin from week to week I recommend that you notice the column devoted to Youth Ministry. Nic will be including on a regular basis a brief summary of the content of their Sunday evening "Life Nights". These sessions have a flow and sequence in presenting to our teens the Catholic faith in an engaging manner. Even if you are not a teen yourself, even if you have teens in your particular household, I hope you will notice the content being presented to the teens on a regular basis. It is important that if the whole parish is needed to support each ministry, then the whole parish ought to have at least some small idea of the good things each ministry is accomplishing.

Once again I would like to issue a personal invitation to any adults who are considering becoming members of the Catholic Church to contact me. I will be holding an informational meeting with any candidates looking to enroll in our RCIA classes this year to come together on Thursday, September 8 at 7 pm in the Blessed John Paul II Memorial Library. A previous contact with before the meeting will be very helpful in ascertaining the needs of each individual candidate. Ordinarily the Sacraments of Initiation for Adults are celebrated at the Easter Vigil which will be the evening of April 7, 2012. Please contact me if you have any questions.

Hopefully by now you have taken advantage of the Fall Festival Raffle tickets that are available in the vestibule of the church. Super-Raffle tickets are being sold after each of the Masses each weekend until the drawing at the close of the Festival on September 18. We are grateful for those who have already signed up to volunteer their time for the festival. The sign-up sheets will continue to be posted on the tables in the vestibule until they are filled. Please consider offering us just a little of your time in generous support to the parish.

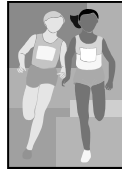
