Curriculum

Our curriculum at Sacred Heart School is comprehensive and challenging, including the subjects of Religion, Math, English, Social Studies, Science, Reading, Music, Art, Computer, Spanish and Physical Education. Enrichment

Enrichment opportunities are available for grades K-8 in a number of ways. Classes rotate weekly and participate in classes that present a variety of topics studies in-depth using art, literature and technology.

ARTS Day is an annual event when the entire school participates in hands-on art activities taught by local artists and artisans.

Sacred Heart supports dual enrollment with the Rockwood School District TAG (Talented And Gifted) program for students in grades K-5.

Technology

Throughout the last several years we have budgeted resources to improve our technology. Currently we have a 30-computer lab, as well as a cart with 30 laptops and at least two desktops in every classroom. A wireless network connects all systems to the Internet throughout the campus. Kindergarten through 8th grade uses the computer as an integral tool, utilizing software such as Excel and Power Point for projects and presentations. Computers are used to supplement student learning by providing research, study aids, and online support materials available from the publishers of most of our textbooks. We have several SMART boards and are continually adding additional boards throughout the school.

Faculty

Our faculty at Sacred Heart is degreed and certified. Almost half of our full time teachers have advanced degrees. The faculty and staff work together to:

Preschool and Kindergarten

We offer a halfday three-year-old program that meets two days a week, and a halfday four-year-old program that meets three mornings a week. We have a degreed and certified preschool teacher as well as an aid in our preschool.

Our Kindergarten is a full day program with an option for parents to take their children home at 11:00 two days a week. Our Kindergarten students participate in all curricular areas including Art, P.E. Music, Spanish and Computer.

After-School Care

Our Aftercare program is operated in-house to ensure continuity in expectations. We have an adult who supervises the program along with our 8th graders who serve as helpers creating leadership opportunities for them and a family environment for all who participate. The program is flexible, reasonably priced and enables families to pay as they use the program.
